His first job was as a nuclear engineer in Raytheon's Advanced Technology group. Thereafter he held technical, managerial and executive positions in a number of businesses and industries. He has published dozens of biblical fiction stories and biblical analysis based on ancient, medieval and contemporary sources. He's been exploring and researching biblical stories and archaeological findings for over two decades.

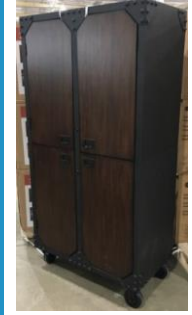
