Guest Speaker and Seuda Shlishit

This week we are honoured to be joined by the Israeli Ambassador to the UK H.E. Daniel Taub who will be addressing us at around 9:00pm after Mincha which this week has been changed to 8:30pm. The address will be on the current situation in Israel and will be followed by a Q&A and Maariv. A seuda shlishit will also be provided and has been kindly sponsored by Louise and David Gould.

With over two decades of experience in Israel's Ministry of Foreign Affairs, H.E. Daniel Taub has played a key role in a wide range of diplomatic, legal and political arenas. As Principal Deputy Legal Adviser of Israel's Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ambassador Taub served as legal adviser to Israel's missions to the United Nations in New York and Geneva, and represented Israel in many multilateral fora.

Ambassador Taub was extensively involved in the Israeli-Palestinian peace process, helping negotiate most of the agreements reached between the two sides, and heading the Israeli side of the Culture of Peace track of negotiations. He was also an active member of Israel's negotiation team in the Israel-Syrian negotiations. Within Israel's foreign ministry he developed and taught training programmes for Israeli diplomats in negotiation strategies and communications skills. In his army service, Ambassador Taub served as a combat medic and as a reserve officer in the IDF's international law division. Ambassador Taub holds degrees from the universities of Oxford, London, and Harvard.
