## Week 6 Parashat Matot-Masei / פרשת מטות-מסעי

This Shabbat, Magen Avot is back in the Hendon Hall Hotel (Garrick Room). Please note that on Friday night we will be starting at the earlier time of **7.15pm**. Magen Avot is a new shul and community supported by Chief Rabbi Ephraim Mirvis and the United Synagogue. Our inaugural service took place on Friday 12 June 2015 in the presence of the Chief Rabbi and over three hundred attendees. Highlights so far have included a talk and seuda shlishit with H.E. Ambassador Daniel Taub. Additional highlights include Chief Rabbi Ephraim Mirvis speaking about his visit with H.M. The Queen (during Her Majesty's state visit to Germany) to the site of the Bergen-Belsen prisoner of war and concentration camp.

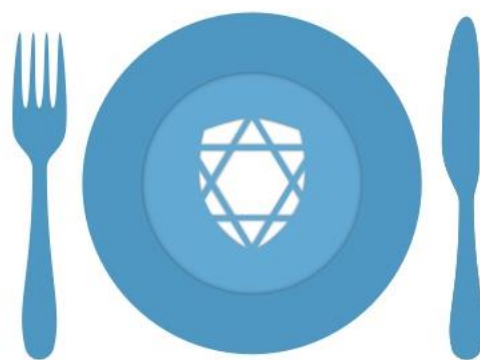
