### **Kol Nidre Appeal**

Our Kol Nidrei appeal this year includes two special charities that we have chosen, one in the UK and one in Israel.

Our **UK** charity is the **North London HTVC Charity Fund**, which directly supports needy families in North London.

Our **Israel** charity is **Yad Sarah**, Yad Sarah is Israel's largest national volunteer organization. It is best known for its free loans of over 244,000 pieces of medical and rehabilitative home-care equipment annually, enabling sick, disabled, elderly and recuperating patients to live at home. This saves Israel's economy an estimated \$320 million in hospital fees and long-term care costs each year. One out of every two Israeli families has been helped by Yad Sarah. Yad Sarah receives no government funding, but relies on donations to meet its \$23 million operating budget.
