# Edwin Shuker

Living in harmony with our Muslim neighbours:

What can be learnt from centuries of Jewish Experience in Arab Lands?

**Edwin Shuker** is an international businessman, human-rights activist and philanthropist with a wide range of educational, communal and charitable involvement.

Born in Baghdad in 1955, Edwin escaped from Iraq with his family across the northern borders into Iran. At the age of 16 he arrived in the UK and graduated from Leeds University with a degree in Mathematics. As a public speaker, Edwin has managed together with his colleagues to put the subject of Jews from Arab countries on the international agenda and regularly delivers presentations on Middle Eastern topics at renowned venues like the British House of Commons, the European Parliament and the United Nations. Edwin is the Special Envoy to the President of the European Jewish Congress on Interfaith and refugees. He is a member of the Executive of the Board of Deputies of British Jews. He lives in London UK with his wife Esther and has three children. Edwin understands the concerns our community may often feel, and the nuances of this complex issue. He will share with us his insight and experience for the benefit of the community as a whole.
