Yellow Candle Project

A flyer has been circulated about the Yellow Candle Project that is being supported community wide to commemorate "Yom Hashoa" Holocaust Memorial Day. This amazing project was started a few years ago in the United States and has since grown, and is now supported around the world. Fully funded by the founders, this is a meaningful way of remembering the atrocities that befell our people and others during the second world war. We have a supply of Yellow candles along with name tags of some of the victims and ask that you collect one of these and join Magen Avot and world Jewry in lighting a Yellow Candle on the evening of 11 April 2018, in memory of somebody who perished. His Jewish education is from yeshivot in Monsey, NY, Manchester, and Jerusalem, and he has a degree in Maths from Manchester University, a postgrad Certificate in Counselling Skills from Glasgow Caledonian University, and a PGCE in Mathematics from Middlesex University. He is married to Suzanne, and their primary occupation is looking after their three gorgeous children. He endeavours to use his love of Jewish education and tradition to promote an open, exciting Orthodox Judaism to all ages and of all levels of Jewish observance. He is passionate about exploring contemporary issues from a Jewish perspective, current trends in Jewish law, thought and practise, and its interface with the modern world and society.



Magen Avot Sale of Chametz - מכירת חמץ

As in previous years you are invited to avail yourself of the facility to sell your Chametz for the duration of Pesach in order to avoid transgressing the Torah prohibition of owning leaven during the course of the Festival. It is preferable to see Rabbi Ginsbury personally to arrange the sale but in case of absolute necessity you may use this form which should be returned to the Shul Office, 18 Raleigh Close, NW4 2TA by no later than **MONDAY 26th MARCH 2018**.

Please ensure that all *Chametz* which is to be included in the sale is placed into a specific location (e.g. spare room, larder, shed or garage) which should be locked or securely sealed for the duration of *Pesach*.

Rabbi Ginsbury will be available for the sale of Chametz, as of Sunday 18th March* 2018, (*18th March 10.30 – 11.30am ONLY) on Sunday, Monday and Friday mornings from 10.00 – 11.30 a.m. at the Shul Office, Monday and Thursday evenings 9.30 – 10.30 p.m. at his home, 31 Green Walk NW4, [LAST SESSION, OTHER THAN BY APPOINTMENT, WEDNESDAY 28TH MARCH].
