US 70th Anniversary Trip to Israel

Linda and Laurence Lovat together with Karina and Ashley Katz joined 160 people from the United Synagogue on their 5 day 70th Birthday Israel Trip. It was a very powerful experience and included meetings with David Quarry, British Ambassador to Israel, the previous Israeli ambassador to Britain, Daniel Taub, and our own Chief Rabbi Ephraim Mirvis. The group visited a range of places including Independence Hall in Tel Aviv where the Israeli Declaration of Independence was made, the Mossad Centre, the Atlit Detainee Camp Museum and the Herzl Museum in Jerusalem. A fascinating talk was delivered by Micky Rosenfeld of the Israel Police overlooking the Kotel and by David Horowitz, founding editor of The Times of Israel, at the King David Hotel. The group was given astonishing insights into the work of Mossad by Mossad agents, the Israeli military by senior military commanders and the current challenges for the state by senior security personnel and journalists. The tour ended with a spectacular meeting with the current Israeli President Reuben Rivlin and a visionary overview of how Israel is at the forefront not only of high-tech and innovation but also how it is working to change the parameters of broader, societal problems so that our country can truly become an Or La'Goyim. The tour was excellent, well organised and the participants would strongly encourage other members of Magen Avot to take advantage of any future tour opportunities offered by the US.
