### **NOVEMBER 9-10, 2018**

On November 9–10, 1938, the Nazis destroyed hundreds of shuls and thousands of Jewish businesses in what became known as Kristallnacht, or ‘Night of the Broken Glass’.

This year marks the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the pogrom. Many shuls are leaving a light on overnight on Shabbat to commemorate the tragedy.
