

Shabbat Neshama (this week) with Debbie Meyer





Building on the momentum created by the hugely successful Neshama Festival, a landmark Torah learning event for women that took place last year, the Office of the Chief Rabbi has launched 'Shabbat Neshama' to be delivered in synagogues across the UK. Shabbat Neshama will put accomplished female educators on centre stage over the course of the Shabbat. Shabbat Neshama takes place this Shabbat on Shabbat Shira, when Parshat Beshalach is read, which tells the story of Miriam's song after the splitting of the Red Sea and the Song of Deborah is sung in the Haftarah. This Shabbat is often linked to and used to celebrate women in Judaism. Magen Avot is fortunate to have Debbie Meyer as our speaker for Shabbat Neshama. Debbie is a popular lecturer at LSJS, she has a degree in law from Hebrew University, qualified as a solicitor in Israel and the UK and is a graduate of the LSJS Susi Bradfield Women Educators' Fellowships.
