Magen Avot learning programme on the first night of **Shavuot, Motzei Shabbat 8 June** is as follows:-

Rabbi Yogev Cohen was born and raised in Israel where he studied for many years under his father in law Rav Eliezer Melamed a leading posek in the Dati Leumi world and author of the highly acclaimed Peninei Halacha series. Rav Yogev and his family moved to London in November 2018 to establish Shelanu, connecting Israelis with their Jewish identity and each other. He holds an advanced semicha of 'Rav Ir' from the Chief Rabbinate of Israel and earned two Law degrees as well as an undergraduate degree in Education. He has directed numerous educational projects, and lectures widely on contemporary issues.

Rabbi Jonny Roodyn was educated at the City of London School and spent two years in Yeshivat Kerem B'Yavneh before returning to study at the London School of Economics. Next, he spent 5 years studying in Yeshivas Mir and the Jerusalem Kollel. Founding member of the Beit Midrash programme. Now working full time for Jewish Futures. Author of a number of Halachik works including Yonas Eliem on laws of mourning, Yonasi Tamasi on preparing bridegrooms for marriage, Kitzur Dinei Shmitta and Shiurei Halacha on laws of Shabbos and Yom Tov.

Glenn Bezalel is head of Religion, Philosophy & Ethics at St Helen's School for Girls. A graduate of both Yeshivot Kerem B'Yavneh and Har Etzion (Gush), he is studying for Semicha at Montefiore Kollel. He is also completing a Ph.D in Education at Cambridge University.

Tamar Weizer is currently an executive recruitment manager, having previously worked for the Israeli Secret Service for nine years, followed by Teva Pharmaceutical Industries.
