## Tisha B'Av Programme – Full schedule next week

On Tisha b'Av afternoon, we are privileged to welcome Mrs Lily Ebert to Magen Avot who will speak about her experiences in Nazi Germany during World War 2. Lily Ebert is a Holocaust survivor. In 1944, when she was just 14 years old, the Nazis deported her and her family from her Hungarian hometown of Bonyhád to Auschwitz. She was with her mother, brother and three sisters. Upon arrival the family were split up, either directed left or right. Lily's mother, brother and sister, were told to go right and were taken to the gas chambers and crematorium. Lily and her two sisters went another way; they never saw the others again. The only possession that Lily was able to keep with her on her journey was her gold pendant, given to her by her mother, which remarkably survived the camp with her, hidden in the heel of her shoe. Mrs Ebert will be speaking in shul at 5.00pm. There will also be a screening of the film: "From where shall my help come?" - the story of two sisters: Fanny Rozelaar and Betty Meir.
