Motzei Shabbat 1 February there will be a talk at **7.30pm** in Shul on: "How Families in Torah illuminate our understanding of Mental Health". There will be 3 speakers and a Q&A will follow.

Dr Fiona Taylor works as a consultant adult Psychiatrist in Camden and Islington. She is interested in the social determinants of mental illness and has spent a year working in Parliament as a mental health advisor to a Peer in the House of Lords, helping to raise the profile of mental illness and influence government policy.

Hillel Mirvis is a Child and Adolescent Psychotherapist based at Barnet CAMHS. He has a particular interest in therapy with adopted children and disturbed adolescents, and has published several papers in these areas.

Dr Richard Taylor has been a GP for over 20 years. He has a special interest in Mental health and Education. Richard holds a diploma in Child Health, a Postgraduate Certificate in Medical Education and has a BSc in Medical History. He has been an undergraduate tutor at UCLH medical school and is a Postgraduate GP trainer with the London Specialty School for GP education.
