

The "Four Kingdoms" tour is a unique experience looking at those kingdoms that have dominated over the Temple in Jerusalem: Babylon, Persia, Greece and Rome.

We will examine highlights from each of the four major kingdoms through history, archaeology, Tanach, Talmud and Midrash.

Each of these Kingdoms, or Empires, has a unique character, flavour, and contribution to the Jewish narrative. We will examine this vision as it pertains to each kingdom, through the excellent exhibitions of museums around the world.



Nachliel Selavan (36), originally from the Old City in Jerusalem, has been guiding Tanach and Jewish History tours in museums since 2016. He has recently moved back to Israel after 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> years in the US. He also runs a Tanach Study podcast on Archaeology and the Parasha.
