From Cultured Meat to Corona - Bringing the Future to Life in the Lab

with Professor Shulamit Levenberg

Shulamit Levenberg is the Dean of the Faculty of Biomedical Engineering at the Technion and director of the Technion centre for 3D Bioprinting. She is also the Chief Scientific Officer of Aleph Farms - creators of the world's first lab-grown steak.

Prof. Levenberg holds a PhD from the Weizmann Institute of Science and a Post-Doctorate from MIT. She has won numerous international prizes, authored over 100 scientific publications and was selected by "Scientific American" as one of the world's 50 leading scientists.

A Thorn in the Desert (Continued)

And then I heard the sound of a helicopter coming towards me. It was no use though; it wouldn't be able to see me in the huge expanse of the desert! I just begged Hashem to save me.

I could not move. I could not wave a flag, blood everywhere. I felt my eyes close! This was it then. But still asking for Hashem's help.

Well, the helicopter landed right by me, and the pilot, first aid kit in hand, jumped down and ran up to me. He cleaned out the wound and stopped the bleeding with a very tight bandage. He had to give me oxygen but finally I came round and stood up. A bit dizzy but okay. Once he was satisfied that I was okay, the pilot climbed back into the helicopter and it rose into the sky and flew away."

Of course, Rabbi Ostreicher had seen some of that and now asked Yehuda: "Did you ask the pilot's name?"

"I did and he told me he was a pilot in the Israel army, on his way to the south of Israel, towards Eilat. He told me what had happened. "I suddenly received a call over the helicopter radio that I should land right where I was and take my first aid kit with me as soon as I landed. That's what I did and saw you barely conscious on the sand. I'm an experienced paramedic so I knew what to do."

"Once he checked that I was feeling a lot better he left, and I walked back to the Yeshiva. And here I am!"
Rabbi Ostreicher said to Yehuda: "The power of your davening was what saved you. I have no other explanation!"

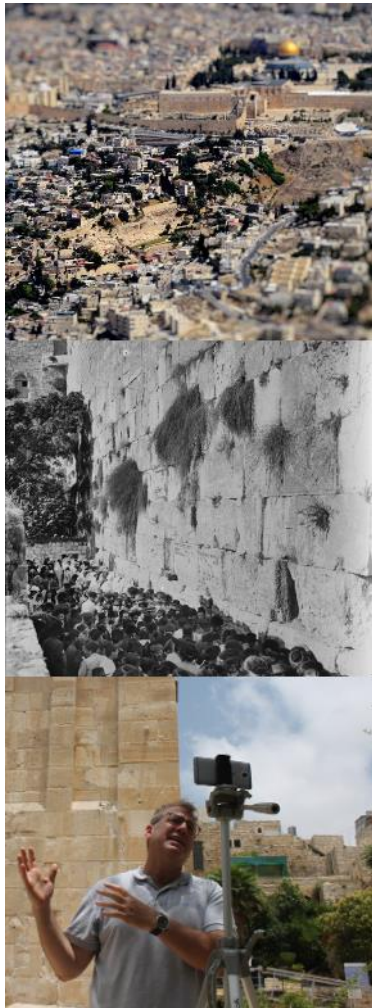
