NOTICE OF AGM

The AGM for Magen Avot will be held on Sunday 9 May 2021 at 8.00pm via Zoom (details to follow). The election, if one is required, will be by means of electronic voting and will commence on Motzei Shabbat 1 May and will end on Thursday 6 May. This will be online via the US Members Portal or via a confidential telephone poll (to be confirmed). A nomination form has been sent to members for the positions below. No person shall be duly nominated unless he or she shall have been nominated by at least three members who are themselves qualified to vote (or nominate) under the US Bye-Laws.

- Chair
- Vice-Chair
- Financial Representative (to hold office for 2 years)
- 2 Gabbaim (wardens)
- 1 Women's Officer
- 5 male members of the Magen Avot Council
- 5 female members of the Magen Avot Council
- Board of Deputies representative

The Chair, Vice-Chair, Financial Representative, two Gabbaim, and the Women's Officer, will make up the Honorary officers.

Nomination forms must be returned no later than 3.00pm on **Wednesday** 14 April 2021. All nominations received after that time or containing a greater number of names than there are respective offices to fill, will be invalid. The Nomination forms must be filled out correctly and signed and may be scanned to Magen Avot administrator Daniella Radomsky at admin@magenavot.com.

Please note that in the current climate, email nominations, (not WhatsApp) and email acceptance of a nomination are acceptable. A member nominating must put their full name on their email, as must the member accepting the nomination. Each member nominating must do so from their own identifiable email address, in other words, if two members in a household are nominating, they should do so from different email addresses.

Qualifications for Standing as a Candidate

To be eligible to stand for election, a candidate for any post must have been at the time of the election:

- A member of Magen Avot on the nomination date
- Eighteen years old or over
- A member of a United Synagogue or an Affiliate or Associate synagogue for the whole of the twelve months immediately preceding the date of the election, and
- Not more than a year in arrears in payment of their membership subscriptions

Qualifications for Voting

- A member of Magen Avot
- Eighteen years old or over
- A member of a United Synagogue or an Affiliate or Associate synagogue for the whole of the twelve months immediately preceding the date of the election, and
- Who is not, at the time of the election, more than a year in arrears in payment of their membership subscriptions.
- Please note that a candidate will not be eligible for election unless he or she has signed that he/she is willing to stand for election and to act in accordance with the terms of the United Synagogue Constitution.

A candidate may not stand for more than one local Honorary Officer position. Please note that a list of candidates, who have been duly nominated for various positions, will be distributed no less than 7 days prior to the AGM.

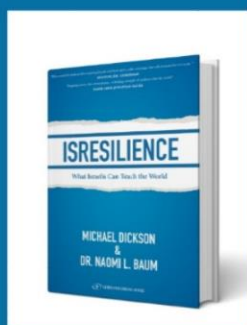
