Magen Avot and the Board of Deputies of British Jews ("The Board")

Magen Avot is now represented on the Board. Its functions and spheres of activity cover almost every aspect of the life of Jews in the UK as well as our engagement with Israel. The Board's formal objectives include:-

- a) Protect, support, and defend the interests, religious rights and customs of Jews and the Jewish Community.
- b) Consider and, if necessary, make representations [......] to government bodies and other competent authorities.
- c) Defend and ensure the security, safety, well-being and standing of British Jews.
- d) Take such appropriate action as lies within its power to advance Israel's security, welfare and standing.
- e) Support and seek to protect Jews and Jewish communities outside the UK.
- *f) Promote a better understanding of the Jewish Community within the UK and, to that end, develop relations with other ethnic and minority groups.*
- g) Provide a co-ordinating role over Jewish communal activities.

These functions are discharged through three Divisions:

1. International Division

- Advocacy and education on Israel
- Support for peacebuilding in the Middle East
- Countering international racism, extremism, and anti-Semitism
- Protecting religious freedoms
- Opposing post Holocaust revisionism

2. Defence and Group Relations

- Regular engagement with main UK Parliamentary Parties
- Promoting religious freedoms- Shechita, Brit Mila and Family law issues etc
- Combating extremism (ie within political parties, football clubs etc)
- Combating online and social media harm
- Inter faith engagement and standing up for all persecuted faiths abroad
- Campus Affairs- protecting Jewish students at University or FE Colleges

3. Communities and Education

- Regional issues
- Heritage and Archives
- Holocaust Education
- Education on Israel's diverse culture, history, and modern developments
- Working with UK educators to represent the Jewish communal interests ie faith policy in schools, religious education, reviewing school books and source material
- Engagement with 200 member organisations such as JAMI, Jewish Women's Aid Campaign, Mental Health awareness Shabbat

In addition, **Special Interest** groups deal with: Family Law, Eco Synagogue, Social Justice Committee, Social action – Mitzvah Day, showing solidarity with Gypsy and Roma groups, Equalities (working to increase the representation of under-represented and minority groups - women, learning disabled, youth, Charedi community, LGBTQ+ groups).

As your Deputy I will reflect the views of the Members of Magen Avot on matters of concern to them and bring them to the attention of the President and Executive to the Board.
