




Board of Deputies Report January 2022

At the January Plenary meeting of the Board:-

- The President Reported on her meeting with the Director General of the BBC expressing her concern about reporting of the Oxford Circus Bus attack and other antisemitism issues and a perceived anti-Israel stance. A written response is awaiting from Tim Davie shortly.
- The Board passed by a 2/3 majority the following Motion: "The Board of Deputies hereby censures the Jewish National Fund UK (JNF UK) for failing to disavow the inflammatory and bigoted remarks of its Chair Samuel Hayek".
- The President had pressed Netflix to commission a documentary about the antisemitism of famous author Roald Dahl. They have resisted this so far, but pressure will continue.
