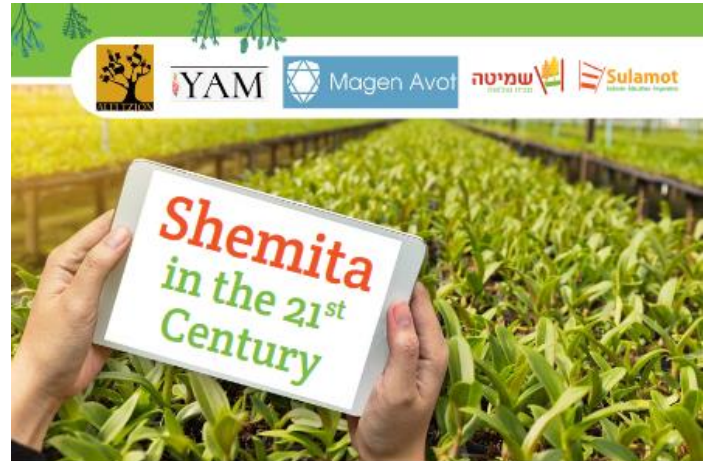
Friday 25 February
