North West London Eruv Appeal

The North West London Eruv was established in 2003. It has transformed life for all of us on Shabbat across the community. Many people who use the Eruv as an essential element of each Shabbat do not give a thought to how it is funded.

Fund raising for the North West London Eruv over recent years to meet the costs of maintenance and supervision has been carried out on ad hoc basis. You may have kindly donated from time to time. In order to secure the future of the Eruv they would like to put things on a more formalised basis.

Members of the community including members of Magen Avot are being asked to become regular Eruv donors. In order to ensure that it is funded, each of us must take individual responsibility and must "carry our share" of the cost of the Eruv. This is your opportunity to show your support.

For 2022 they would like as many people as possible to be Eruv Sponsors donating £180 now and committing to be Eruv Partners in future years by donating £50 annually. They need your help in order to be able to carry on. The following payment options are available:-



We strongly encourage as many people as possible to donate £50 a year – about £1 a week – to cover the costs of this essential community institution which is used by so many people.
