Gila Fine is the editor in chief of Maggid Books (Koren Publishers Jerusalem). Gila is also a teacher of Aggada at the Pardes Institute of Jewish Studies, exploring the stories of the Talmud through philosophy, literary criticism, psychoanalysis, and pop-culture. Gila is the former editor of Azure: Ideas for the Jewish Nation and has previously taught at Hebrew University, Tel Aviv University, and the London School of Jewish Studies. Haaretz has called her "a young woman who is on her way to becoming one of the more outstanding Jewish thinkers of the next generation."

Yom HaShoah

Message from BoD President Marie van der Zyl: The unique Jewish tragedy of the Holocaust, is now passing from suffering and memory into history. We are launching the "Legacy of the Holocaust" initiative at the National Yom Hashoah Ceremony on Wednesday 27 April at 7.30pm. For the last two years, we found that more families marked Yom HaShoah online, lit yellow candles and remembered together. For many of us, seeing elderly relatives in person hasn't been possible, so it was vital for us this year to ensure that we could involve those survivors and refugees who are able, to gather in person and be a central part of the National Ceremony. We are delighted and honoured therefore that Jewish Care, the home of the Holocaust Survivors Centre, has agreed to open its doors to be to be the main base for our National Ceremony. Broadcast live across the UK (and the world) at YomHaShoah.org.uk, YouTube and on all social media channels, the intimate studio setting will play host to choristers, primary school choirs, musicians, guest speakers and most importantly, testimony from survivors and refugees. Hybrid technology will even allow you to be part of the ceremony, as families from across the UK are invited to sign up to be part of our live interactive "Yellow Candle" lighting ceremony as part of this year's National Commemoration. Originally planned for 2020, this year sees the delayed launch of our Yom HaShoah 'Legacy of the Holocaust' initiative, where over the next year, 200 commemorative legacy boards will be installed in synagogues, schools and community buildings across the UK, creating a permanent reminder and local focal point "to remember, to tell and to never forget" on Yom HaShoah. Information on how your community can receive your free legacy board will be announced during the National Ceremony and the details will be communicated in the weeks ahead.
