Online Child Protection Training

The United Synagogue offers training to any volunteers or staff in a child facing role. This online Child Protection training is taking place on **Monday 16 May 2022 from 6.30pm** to 9.30pm. The training is certificated and valid for 3 years. This training is very important, not only so that we comply with our legal obligations, but so that everyone in a child facing role fully understands the issues involved in spotting signs and symptoms of abuse, how to deal with any concerns or disclosures that may arise, as well as online grooming. The United Synagogue have run this training a number of times to various groups within the United Synagogue. Our trainer, Nicole Williamson of Education Child Protection Ltd, is extremely experienced and fully understands the United Synagogue and our procedures in this area. The United Synagogue is ever more conscious of the threat to children and vulnerable people from people who would seek to do them harm – whether by physical, emotional, or sexual abuse or by neglect. Within every United Synagogue community therefore, there is a Community Safeguarding Coordinator (CSC). This is someone within the community who is the primary point of contact at local level for members of the shul if they have any concerns in relation to child protection (protection of under 18s) or the protection of vulnerable adults. The CSC at Magen Avot is Cecil Taitz. If you have any concerns about someone within our community, please reach out to Cecil. He can be reached on **07768 763 319** or treasurer@magenavot.com. Should you wish to contact the United Synagogue safeguarding team at Head Office, please contact the US Child Protection line on **020 3758 8440** and your voicemail will be re-directed. If at any time you believe a child may be at serious imminent risk, please contact 999. Please confirm to our Community Safeguarding Coordinator, Cecil Taitz at treasurer@magenavot.com if you wish to attend. Attendees of the Child Protection training must be present for the full 3 hours.
