

2. Sof Zman Kriat Shema: **9.51am (Day 1) | 9.52am (Day 2)**
3. The final 40 shofar blasts will take place after **12.50pm**
4. Tashlich is usually done before Mincha on the first day, but may be done even until Hoshanah Rabbah
5. No work for the 2nd day should be done before nightfall
6. Candle Lighting for 2nd night is after nightfall at **7.37pm**
7. T'Zom Gedaliah (Wed 28) fast **5.17am** until **7.26pm**
