

Egypt is hosting the 27th UN Climate Change Conference of the Parties <u>COP27</u> in Sharm El-Sheikh from 6th to 18th November 2022. The aim will be to build on the outcomes of COP26 to deliver action on several issues critical to tackling the climate emergency – from urgently reducing greenhouse gas emissions, building resilience and adapting to the inevitable impacts of climate change, to delivering on the commitments to finance climate action in developing countries. EcoShabbat is the opportunity for our shul community to be a part of these conversations and to act in ways to improve our sustainability.


We will, at this especially poignant time, honour and remember the late HM Queen Elizabeth II and all she did as Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces


