This Shabbat is JAMI MHAS which aims to raise the profile of mental health within the Jewish community. This year the MHAS falls on Parashat Va'eira. In Parashat Va'eira, Moshe tells the Jewish nation that their woes have ended, and that redemption is at hand. This should have been a time of elation, but the Israelites were too overwhelmed by their own stresses to absorb this message. They had lost hope and could not imagine a positive future for themselves. Stresses in life may be inevitable but it is comforting to have hope that the future can bring our own personal redemption and in turn can bring us from darkness into light. The theme of the MHAS 2023 will be "Community". How does our sense of community help or hinder our mental health? In what ways can we support one another in our community?
