Sale of Chometz - Pesach 5783

Date of Sale: Wednesday 5th April 2023 – 14th Nisan 5783

I, the undersigned, fully empower and authorise Rabbi Yoni Golker to act in my place and stead and, on my behalf, to sell any Chometz possessed by me (knowingly or unknowingly) including any food in respect of which there is a doubt or possibility that it might contain Chometz, and all kinds of Chometz mixtures, and to lease all places wherein the Chometz owned by me is stored and found, especially in the premises specified below, or elsewhere.

Rabbi Golker has full authority to sell or lease all Chometz and all places wherein the Chometz owned by me is found, by any transaction in any manner which he deems fit and proper, and for such time as he believes necessary, in accordance with the detailed terms and conditions set out in the agreed Contract of Sale which he will draw up. This authorisation is made a part of that Contract.

I also give Rabbi Golker power and authority to appoint any proxy he deems fit in his place, with full power to sell or lease as provided herein. The above-given powers are to be exercised in conformity with all Torah and Rabbinical regulations and laws, and also in accordance with the laws of the country.

- 04/04: Bedikat Chametz should be done at nightfall on Tuesday night from 8.21pm
- 05/04: There is a Siyum on Wednesday morning after Shacharit at 7.30am (Shimon Shaerf will be making Siyum for תענית בכורות)
- 05/04: Latest time to eat chametz is 10.51am
- 05/04: Latest time to burn chametz is 11.58am
- 05/04: An Eruv Tavshillin should be made before Yom Tov in order to allow preparation from Yom Tov to Shabbat
- 05/04: Remember to light a 48 hour candle | Seder should not begin before nightfall at 8.23pm
- 06/04: No preparation to be made for second day Yom Tov before nightfall
- 06/04: Yom Tov candles for the second day should be lit from a pre-existing flame after nightfall
- 11/04: Remember to light a 48 hour "Yahrzeit" candle prior to candle lighting in order to light second night candles
- 12/04: Candles for 8th day Yom Tov should be lit before 8.41pm
- 13/04: Neilat HaChag speakers TBC
