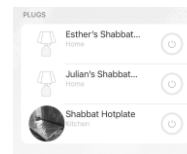
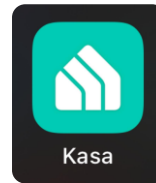
Mazal Tov!

EcoSynagogue Tip (Continued)



Following on from last week's tip: People have pointed out that by using a smart plug for appliances over the Yom Tov period is extremely useful when needing to heat food up over Chag and over the following or preceding Shabbat when timings are very different. So, buy a smart plug and use as a time switch for your hot plate and other appropriate devices. This is much more energy efficient than using a manual time switch that is the same for each day. Smart plugs allow you to set a program each week before Shabbat directly from an app on your phone. In addition, many in the community have used these smart plugs for their Shabbat lamps so they are automated to come on before Shabbat and switch off immediately after Shabbat. How many times have you got to the next Friday and realised your Shabbat lamp has been on all week! A cost saving for you and an environmental saving also. Kasa is a commonly used brand of smart plugs but there are many on the market.
