EcoJudaism Tip

Beyond Shabbat time switches it is also worth switching to LEDs and compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs) which can help with saving huge amounts of energy and in turn cost. They are more efficient than defunct incandescent and halogen bulbs. CFLs use 60-80% less energy and LEDs use an astonishing 90% less. In a kitchen with 30 halogen downlights burning over Shabbat the LED equivalent would be to only pay for the cost of 3 of those bulbs if all 30 were LED! It's time to switch.
