The weekly Tehillim session continues at Raleigh Close with Mincha **7.30pm**, Maariv **7.45pm**, and Tehillim **8.00pm**.



The trip details are as follows:-

Accommodation: One night at the Ilan Hotel Lublin (Yeshivat Chachmei Lublin) and one night at the Wilga Hotel Krakow.
