We will be reading: "My Name is Asher Lev" by Chaim Potok (1929-2002) - Rabbi, painter and one of America's greatest authors. "My Name is Asher Lev" is the story of a Hasidic Jewish boy who is born with a tremendous artistic gift. His father, who is a senior representative of one of the Hasidic movements is not supportive. His mother, as all mothers do, tries to act as intermediary between father and son. Asher's talent deepens. He moves from streetscapes to 'nudes' much to the chagrin of his conservative father and the distress of his long-suffering mother. But that isn't enough. Asher is consumed by his art; by his need to express what it is that he needs to express. He goes to Europe, trying to capture Renaissance style and learn from the masters — it was Europe that gave the world art after all — and on the snowy streets of Paris, after months without painting, he finally finds his apogee.
